

# **SOUTH BOUND BROOK BOROUGH COUNCIL AGENDA MEETING MINUTES**

**Motion by Councilperson Quinlan to open the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilperson Godleski, all ayes.**

Before the meeting was opened to the public the Mayor asked the Borough Engineer if he had anything to report. At this time Councilperson Quinlan tabled his **Motion** to open the meeting to the public. Borough Engineer reported that he had received the information about the demolition of the two buildings and the Prospect Street project. Also spoke about Centers of Place funds being available. A little park next to canal bridge was talked about.

Mayor spoke about a meeting he has scheduled with the Landmark Co. concerning development of the property on Johnson and Main Streets (the Ball Estate).

Councilperson Shoffner asked if Washington Park had opened up the sidewalk along Elizabeth St. They have until this Friday to bring in a plan for opening that up. It is now in the hands of the Building Department.

Councilperson Quinlan re-instated his **Motion** to open the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilperson Godleski, all ayes.

Erica Ciancia - 100 Canal St.

- Asked when the Officer In Charge or Chief of Police will be made official. Councilperson Allenovitch said that it is being worked on.
- Asked about the funds to have amphitheatre by the canal bridge. Money would come from a DOT grant.

**Motion by Councilperson Allenovitch to close the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilperson Quinlan, all ayes.**

Councilperson Conner asked if signs preventing overweight trucks from using Barber Blvd. had been installed. Lt. King said that the Police Department is still doing research on all the signage in town.

Borough Clerk read Resolution concerning going into Closed Session. Reason for this Executive Session is Public Safety. **Motion** by Councilperson Quinlan to approve this Resolution, seconded by Councilperson Conner, all ayes.

**Motion** by Councilperson Conner to return to Public Session, seconded by Councilperson Allenovitch, all ayes.

At this time Councilperson Conner asked the Fire Chief to speak about getting rid of the fire boxes that are still in town. The Chief explained that they want to get rid of all the fire boxes except the one at the firehouse. The sirens would still be activated by the radio. All parties will be notified that the boxes will be removed.

**Motion by Councilperson Godleski to close the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilperson Ormosi, all ayes.**
