- Councilperson Dykes explained the original program for the Bike Race on May 23<sup>rd</sup>. The program became too much in time and costs so it was necessary to tone it down a bit. The opportunity to host one of the events that encompasses the week of the Tour of Somerville presented itself. It would be on Saturday May 29<sup>th</sup>. It would be a 3 race event. The race would originate on High St. west to Van Sickle up to Edgewood Terrace and finish on Elizabeth. Councilperson Dykes introduced Dan from Middle Earth. The new, shorter race course and the use of the parking lot at the school will help to attract families. He will help promote the race and assist in other areas.
